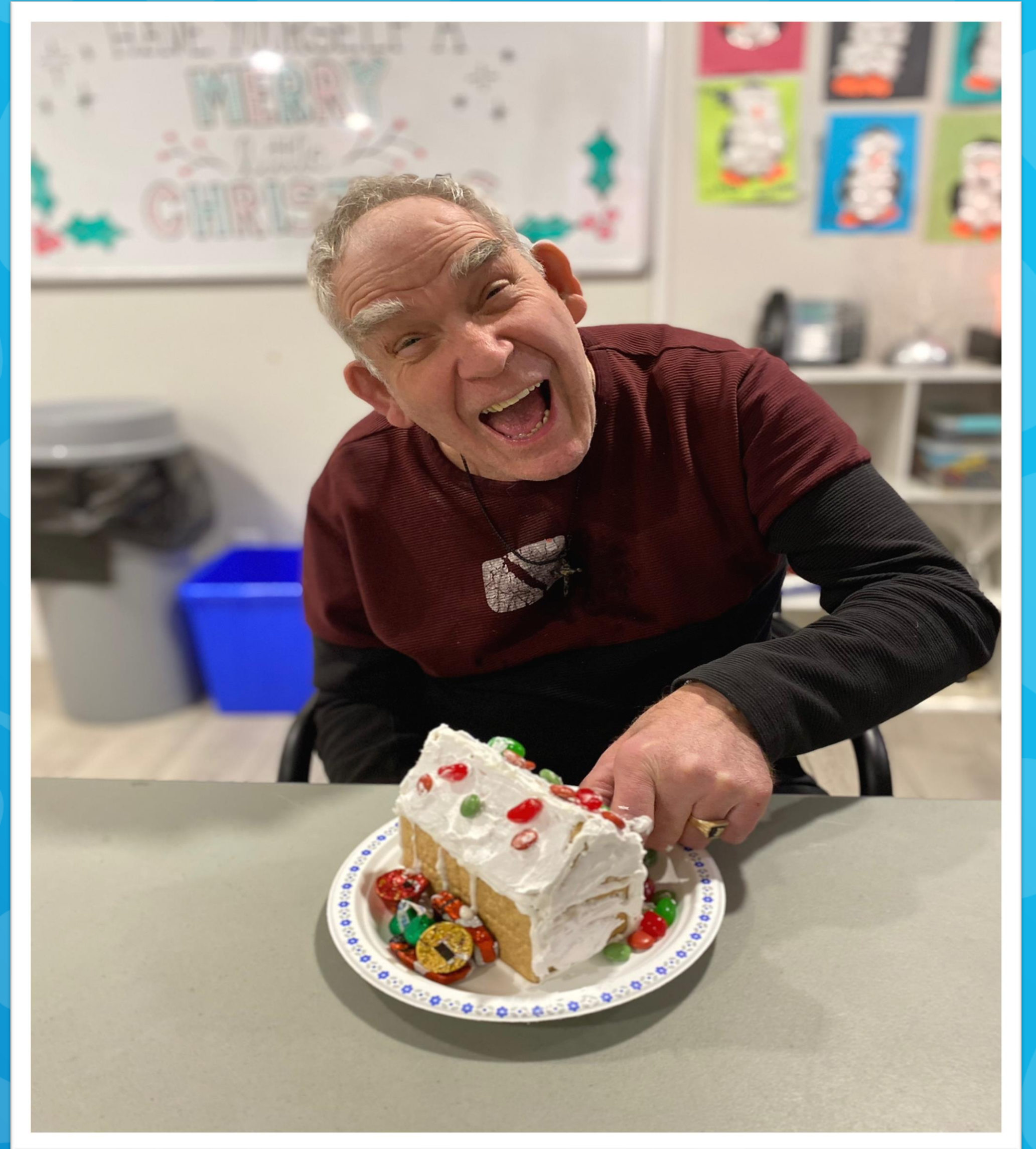

Construction Update

- 2920 14th Street: 35% complete- Estimated construction finish: August 2023
- 706 Brightsand Crescent: 30% complete- Estimated construction finish: September 2023
- 103 Holmes Crescent: 21% complete- Estimated construction finish: November 2023
- Elmwood is currently awaiting the Tender of 3204 Mountbatten Street
- **The above are construction completion timeframes, not move-in timeframes**



Outcomes and Evaluation Update

- Partnership with the University of Saskatchewan – Community University Institute for Social Research (CUISR). Funded by CLSD. This partnership is now in the second year.
- 17 Non- Residents have participated
- Resident portion approved by the Research Ethics Board (REB) in January 2023 and interviews commenced in February
- Approximately 20 residents have chosen to participate in this exciting study!



Family Engagement Groups Update

- Family Engagement Groups continue on a monthly rotational basis.
- All families are welcome and encouraged to participate!
- Interest to participate continues to be limited
- Importance for families to become more informed, provide feedback around 4 key areas identified by families in initial calls in October 2021
- Health and Wellness, Transportation, Programming and Socialization Opportunities (Internal), Community Inclusion Opportunities (External)



Projected Timeframes

- Completion of homes is approximately 14 months, including the required licensing and turn- over of keys to agency
- 2920 14th Street and 706 Brightsand Crescent (Houses #1 & 2) have an anticipated move- in during the fourth quarter (January – March 2024) of 2023/2024 fiscal year.
- 103 Holmes Crescent and 3204 Mountbatten Street (Houses # 3 & 4) has an anticipated move- in during the first quarter (April- June 2024) and second quarter (July- September 2024) of 2024/2025 fiscal year.
- Artificial delay of opening of Houses #3 & 4 to occur to ensure a thoughtful transition plan is in place for each individual. Will be a need to ensure sufficient and trained staff is in place to support residents in their new homes.
- Timeframes for Houses #5- 7 is unknown at this time as approvals have not yet occurred.

Workforce Adjustment Plan Update

- Elmwood and SEIU-West have reached a tentative agreement for a Workplace Adjustment Plan.
- The Plan will support Manor Team Members to have initial bids on Manor Transition Community Homes Support Worker Positions. This unique plan supports:
 - Continuity of Care and Support
 - Person-Centred Practices
 - Recruitment and Retention
- This agreement is currently being reviewed by both Manor and Community Home Team Members.

Future Community Hub

- Based on feedback from our partners (including you!), Elmwood has developed a committee to develop a vision/plan for a Community Hub to ensure individuals living with intellectual disabilities live fulfilled lives. The Hub will:
 - Maintain a community-based hub of services to support recreation and socialization of those served.
 - Maintain the land site location of 2012 Arlington Avenue.
 - Maintain the administration team office space on this site.
- A consulting firm has been retained and work is underway to develop this vision and secure seed funding.

“Our Road to Home”

- A board has been developed to provide all residents with a visual that shows what stage of development their home is in.
- This board explains the transition process using plain language and includes visuals to help in better understanding of the process of transition.
- As construction proceeds, the homes will be moved along the road to the end, which is when the residents move into their new homes!
